

How to Be Successful at EKFC

- Have Good Attendance
 - Know the Attendance Policy
- Be on time to your classes
- Know how to check your grades
 - StudentVue
- Stay after with teachers when they are available
- Do your homework
 - The grades you earn this year stay with you until you graduate. Everything counts in high school! The better you do in high school, the more opportunities you will have upon graduation. Don't eliminate opportunities at such a young age!
 - Turn in your work -- even if it's late or incomplete. Half credit is better than no credit!
- Take advantage of tutoring

 - Bring work to do
- Exams can be hard -- so make sure you put yourself in a situation where your final grade does not depend on the end of the semester exam in your class. Final exams are worth 20% of your final grade in each class.
- If you are failing 2 or more classes, you are not eligible to participate in athletics.

Facts about Credits

- Every class you take is a $\frac{1}{2}$ credit
- You need **22 credits** to earn a diploma at EKHS
- If all classes are passed in a year -- you will earn 6 credits
- You must have **5 credits to become a sophomore** next year
 - This means that you will return as a freshman next year if you fail 3 or more classes during your freshman year.
 - If you have 4.5 credits or less you will be a 9th grader again next year and attend classes at the Freshman Campus.

Graduation Requirements

4 credits in Math	$\frac{1}{2}$ credit in PE
4 credits in English	$\frac{1}{2}$ credit in Health
3 credits in Social Studies	2 years of a World Language
3 credits in Science	1 Credit in Visual, Performing or Applied Arts (VPA)
