**** Residency Requirements ****

ALL students must have the following to register:
(returning and new students, K-12th grade)

1. Current guardian's driver's license with district address - If guardian is not accompanying the student to registration, please provide student with a copy of guardian's driver's license (front and back, if district address is on the back).
2. A current (dates within 12 months of the date of enrollment) closing statement, current signed lease showing lease holder's name, address and contact telephone number, landlord affidavit, current property tax bill or mortgage payment book relating to the property address within the district.
3. Must also provide **TWO** of the following - current bills (within 30 days showing name of parent/guardian and address within district) * Gas bill * Electric bill * Other utility bill * Telephone/cell phone bill * Cable or satellite bill * City water/sewage bill
4. Legal guardians must also provide a copy of a current Probate Court Letter of Guardianship.

School-Age Childcare

School-age childcare is for children kindergarten through 5th grade. Before school childcare is available in all Kentwood Public School elementary buildings. Childcare is available from 6:30 a.m. until school begins. Enrollment for after school childcare at Challenger, Discovery, Endeavor, and Explorer is available from after school until 6:00 p.m. For more information please call the Early Childhood Office at 493-5693.



Full day childcare is available daily at Discovery and Endeavor for 3-5 year olds (**Children must be fully potty trained; no pull-ups allowed.**) All sites are licensed by the State of Michigan and approved to receive FIA reimbursement for those who qualify.

A deposit of \$40 per family is required at the time of enrollment and covers your family for one school year. Deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE! No cash is accepted. Parents will pre-pay for childcare on a weekly basis.

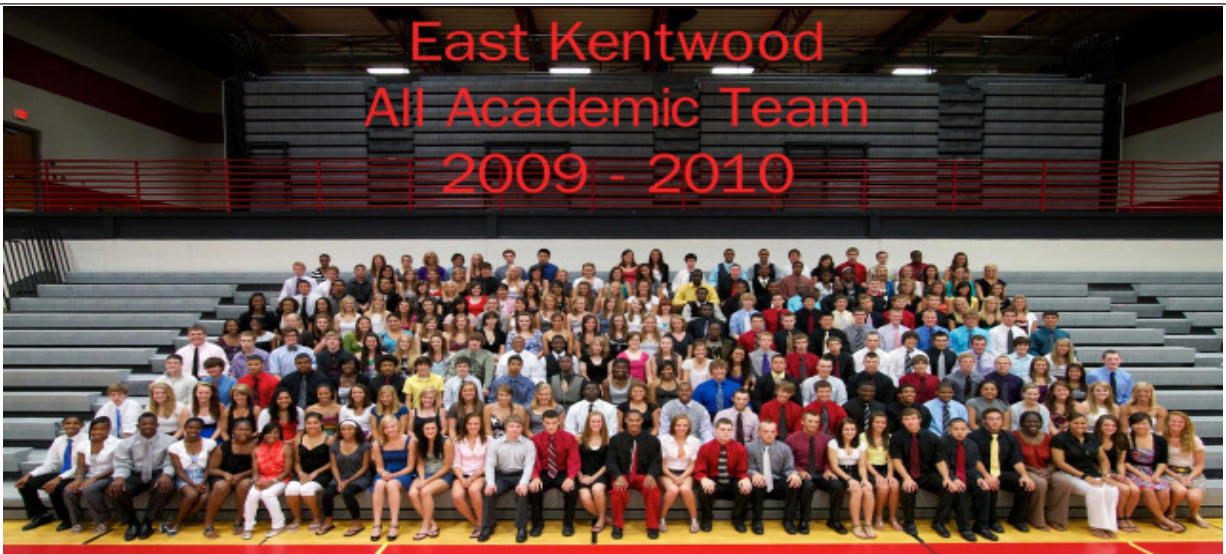

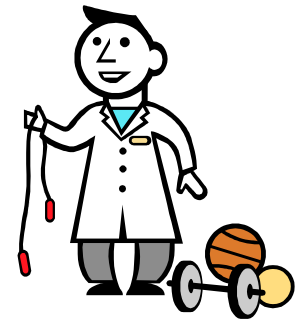

The following is pertinent information regarding the Management Plan:

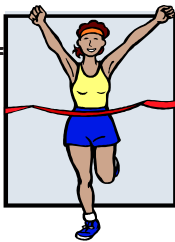
1. The six-month periodic surveillance inspections are performed utilizing in-house staff members.

Pay To Participate

One of the strongest components of the Kentwood Public Schools is athletic programs offered to students of all ages. We continue to be very proud of the variety and scope of these opportunities because they afford our students rich experiences and great personal growth. Due to the recent shortfalls in our state budget allocations coupled with rising costs and expenses, it is necessary to require a participation fee for all student athletes.

The fee is paid **once** annually after the team roster is announced or by the end of the first week of practice.



- * High school fee is \$100
- * Middle school fee is \$60
- * Fee for each KIDS activity is \$5
- * The 78er's Football program is considered a part of the middle school athletic program and participants must submit their \$60 fee before participating.
- * Partial pay-to-participate scholarship applications, based on free and reduced lunch applications, will be made available to Kentwood families needing financial assistance.

Payment will be accepted in cash, money order, or credit/debit card. Personal checks will not be accepted.

During school registration in August or at any time during the school year, students may pay their participation fee at the Athletic/Fine Arts/Facilities office. Middle school athletes should pay their fee at their respective school office.

Falcon Stadium Guidelines

1. K-8 students are to be in attendance with an adult who will stay for the game and be responsible for the students' behavior.
2. High school students will be allowed in only with a Student ID.
3. Fans are asked not to stand along the railing in front of the bleachers.
4. All students are expected to sit in the bleachers during the game.
5. Fans are expected to raise, remove hats, and stand quietly for the National Anthem.
6. Students are to be dressed appropriately.
7. Assist the school district in keeping the stadium clean by putting your trash in trash receptacles.
8. Fans are asked not to go beyond the north end of the bleachers.
9. Exhibit good sportsmanship by cheering for our team positively and by not cheering negatively toward our opponent.

Student Transportation Management

The State of Michigan requires the district to transport students to school if they live more than one and a half miles from school, and the board has determined that it will provide transportation in addition to that required by state statute.

Approved: July 1, 1996

LEGALREF:MCL 380.1321-1322;380.1331; 380.1336;388.1010;R 340.1702; R 340.271-279; R 340.281-282;257.1801 et seq;; Michigan Department of Education Transportation Handbook(Bulletin 431)

1. AM and PM school bus service shall be provided for resident students as follows:
 - a. K-5 residing more than 3/4 of a mile from the school of attendance.
 - b. 6-8 residing more than one mile from the school of attendance.
 - c. 9-12 students residing more than 1 1/4 miles from the school of attendance.
2. AM and PM walking requirements:
 - a. K-5 students may be required to walk up to 1/2 mile to bus stops.
 - b. 6-8 students may be required to walk up to 3/4 mile to bus stops.
 - c. 9-12 students may be required to walk up to one mile to bus stops.
3. Noon school bus service shall be provided for resident students as follows: Kindergarten students residing more than 1/2 mile from the school of attendance.
4. Noon walking requirements: Kindergarten students may be required to walk up to 1/4 mile to bus stops.
5. Kindergarten bus runs will be designated after enrollment is completed. No more than one pick up and one drop off address will be allowed within the attendance area served by the school building.
6. Walking distance will be measured along public street and walkways from the school property as follows:
 - a. Elementary and Secondary - from the closest entrance of the school building off from a public street to:
 - (1) closest residence driveway connecting to a public street
 - (2) the entrance to a mobile home park.
 - (3) the entrance to an apartment complex
 - (4) the entrance to a private drive. The length of the driveway shall be included in the distance.
7. The responsibility of parents whose children are transported at public expense is as follows:
 - a. To ascertain and ensure that their children arrive at the bus stop on time when going to school.
 - b. To provide necessary protection of their children when going to, from, and while at bus stops.
 - c. To accept joint responsibility with the school authorities for proper conduct of their children.
 - d. To make reasonable effort to understand and cooperate with those responsible for student transportation so that bus schedules and times can be maintained.

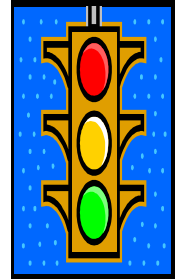

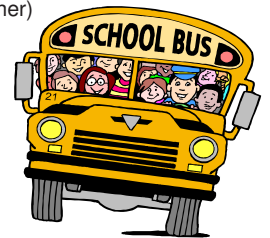

Special Education Transportation:

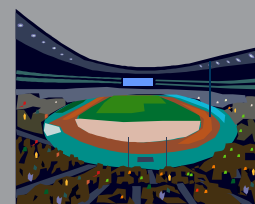
The Special Education Office mailed confirmation letters to families of students in grades K-12 who are expected to ride special transportation during the 2010-2011 school year. If you did not receive a letter and you were expecting special transportation based on your child's IEP, please leave a message at the Special Education office, 554-3980, and someone will contact you to work out details. Remember to include your child's name, attending school for the fall, and your name along with a number to reach you.

Students attending Early Childhood Classes will have transportation arranged after they register during our elementary registration dates. You will receive a letter early in August with details about the classroom and fall procedures. Students who register after the fall dates may not have transportation available on the first day of school.

Falcon Pride Parking

What is the Falcon Pride Lot?

The Falcon Pride Lot is a designated parking lot for those who wish to have a reserved spot during the 2010 Varsity Football season at Falcon Stadium. The parking lot is located directly behind the visitor stands.



What are the benefits?

General public sales will be during registration on August 17-19, 2010 from 8:30 am to 2:00 pm on a first come, first served basis. During registration, Falcon Pride parking permits will be available at the Safety Staff table in the East Wing Cafeteria. All proceeds will go to the Safety Department to cover staffing for various events.

Student Accident Insurance

Kentwood Public Schools, in conjunction with First Agency, Inc., provide student medical insurance coverage for any student injured during school or a student participating in a school-related activity including athletics. This program will be offered again for the 2010-2011 school year.

The coverage is secondary to any student or family medical insurance. In effect, this insurance will cover medical costs for school-related injuries that are not covered by the family's medical insurance as long as the injury falls within the coverage limits.

There is no longer a need for an athlete to purchase supplemental medical coverage. All athletes are covered under the school-related activity portion of this policy.

If a family wishes to improve upon the district's purchased plan, the following options are available:

Option I:

24-hours-a-day Protection Coverage (\$25,000 max)
Grades Pre-K-12 includes all activities and interscholastic sports, except 9-12 football \$255
Grades Pre-K-12 includes all activities except all interscholastic sports \$193

Option II:

At-School Protection Coverage (\$25,000 max)
Grades Pre-K-12 includes all activities and interscholastic sports, except 9-12 football \$ 94
Grades Pre-K-12 includes all activities except all interscholastic sports \$ 55

Option III:

Extended Dental Coverage-Coverage (\$5,000 max) \$ 11

Can only be purchased in conjunction with at-school or 24 hours plans.

These optional policies are especially valuable to parents and guardians without medical insurance coverage or to those with limited coverage. As a supplemental policy, it pays the first \$100 of medical costs after filing on other policies. Those items not covered by other insurance coverage will be paid within the coverage limits.

To enroll, review and complete the application envelope that will be available at all schools during August registration, include the proper premium amount for the plan selected, and return the envelope to your child's school as soon as possible.

Spotlight on Senior Issues

Help for Hearing Loss

Unfortunately for many, hearing loss may prevent them from participating in activities they once enjoyed or may isolate them from family and friends. This doesn't have to be the case; there are many resources to reduce the effects of hearing loss.

Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services (DHHS) in Kent County can provide equipment to help those experiencing hearing loss. Most people just think about hearing aids, which are often rather expensive and may not be an option financially. Staff at DHHS can meet with an individual to help determine what hearing changes they have and how to adapt to them. Equipment is available at little to no cost, depending on income.



Often the devices help with tasks many individuals don't realize are based on auditory ability, such as doorbell flashers or smoke alarms equipped with lights. Other equipment includes amplifiers for phones, televisions, and even pocket amplifiers, which are less costly than hearing aids.

Many older adults who experience hearing loss do not want to admit that their ability to hear clearly is unreliable. Since it can be a gradual process the extent of hearing change may not be realized initially.

"It can be difficult to admit having trouble hearing, even though there are many ways to address this loss," says Katie Prins, Executive Director at Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services. "Sensitivity to the complexities that follow hearing differences is essential when working toward solutions and helping individuals to adjust to the changes they are experiencing." DHHS offers other services including education and support groups.

The Kent County Senior Millage provides funding for the equipment program. There may be a cost-share, depending on income. Donations are always accepted and are used to help more people access the services.

Tuition Based - Preschool

Preschool programs are available for three and four year olds. The preschool programs will be available at Endeavor and Explorer. **A \$130.00 NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT** (applied to tuition) is required at the time of registration. **An activity fee of \$30.00 is also due** at time of registration, a separate check is needed for this fee. A packet of information will need to be filled out at time of registration.

3-year old program – children must be three years old on or before September 3, 2010. Children must be **fully potty trained prior to starting class**. (We do not allow pull-ups; children must be able to go on their own to the bathroom.)

4-year old program – children must be four years old on or before December 1, 2010.

FREE - Preschool Readiness Program

FREE Preschool programs are available for four year olds only. The preschool programs will be available at Bowen, Challenger, Glenwood, Southwood, and Townline Elementary Schools. A packet of information will need to be filled out at time of registration.

Children must be four years old on or before December 1, 2010.
