#### PBIS Championship Behavior



Championship behavior is characterized by a range of positive actions and attitudes that show respect for others, responsibility, and safe choices.. Some key aspects of championship behavior include:

- Respect for Others: A Bowen Falcon who listens
  attentively when others are speaking, shares with peers,
  and values differences and demonstrates respect. They
  show kindness through words and actions and express
  gratitude and appreciation.
- Responsibility: A responsible Bowen Falcon takes care of their personal belongings, completes tasks, and takes responsibility for their actions, including owning up to mistakes.
- Safe Choices: Championship behavior includes the ability to make safe choices, such as waiting for their turn, not interrupting others, and managing emotions when frustrated or upset.

During the month of December, staff members are nominating Bowen students that display championship behavior on a consistent basis. These students earn an ice cream sundae party, one session of free time with Miss Campione, and the opportunity to wear a gold medal to highlight their nomination. We encourage you to ask your Bowen Falcon if he/she has been nominated!
