These tasks help children build responsibility and good habits for the future!

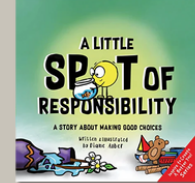
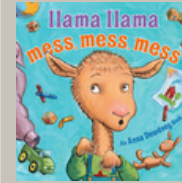
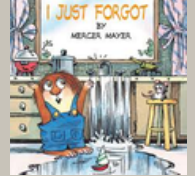
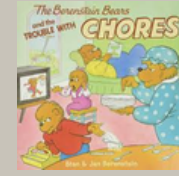
QUICK TIPS TO MAKE IT EASIER
