Child Find (616) 871 – 1000

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires school districts to identify and evaluate all children, from birth to age 25, who live in Michigan and are suspected of having a disability that may affect their educational performance and may need special education programs and/or related services.



Who Is Included?

All children, including children with disabilities who are homeless or wards of the State and children with disabilities attending private schools regardless of the severity of the disability, qualify for the rights outlined in IDEA.
